

Countable and Uncountable Nouns

- **Countable nouns** refer to **things we can count**. We add 's' or 'es' to make the nouns plural. We can also put articles or numbers before the nouns.

e.g. *I am eating **an apple**.*

*There are **three sausages** on the table.*

- **Uncountable nouns** refer to **things we cannot count**. They cannot be plural.
