- Countable nouns refer to things we can count. We add 's' or 'es' to make the nouns plural. We can also put articles or numbers before the nouns.
  - e.g. I am eating **an apple**.

There are **three sausages** on the table.

 Uncountable nouns refer to things we cannot count. They cannot be plural.
