

Making Suggestions

We use 'shall we', 'how about' or 'what about' to make suggestions. We do not change the verb form after 'shall we'. We use the '-ing' form of the verb after 'how about' and 'what about'.

e.g. **Shall we** go to Joyful Park this Sunday?

How about going to the cinema?
